








# End-of-Book Activity

## Let's Make Fresh Milk Pudding!

#### Objective:

To help children understand the benefits of cow's milk and how it can be easily turned into a delicious dessert.

#### What You'll Need:

1 cup of fresh milk

1 teaspoon of gelatin powder (or agar powder)

1 - 2 tablespoons of sugar (adjust to taste)

A small pot and a ladle

Pudding cups or small bowls

#### How to Make It (with adult supervision):

1. Pour the fresh milk into the pot.

2.Add the sugar and gelatin powder.

3.Stir well, then heat over low heat.

4. Continue stirring until everything is completely dissolved

(do not let it boil).

5.Turn off the heat and pour into pudding cups.

6.Let it cool, then refrigerate for about 1—2 hours.

Now your fresh milk pudding is ready to enjoy!

### **Fun Fact:**

Cow's milk comes from well-cared-for female cows.

It's rich in calcium,
which helps strengthen bones.

Besides drinking it, milk can also be used to make

many treats - like pudding,

ice cream, or

shaved ice desserts!
